
DIRECTIONS TO CHRIST LUTHERAN CHURCH

Coming to Christ using IH-35 southbound

1. Take exit 260, FM 2243/Leander Rd. Stay in the right-hand lane. At the next light, FM 2243/Leander Rd. turn right, going west.
2. Continue west on Leander Rd and in .1 miles, turn left at the first street to the left, Luther Dr. Continue south on Luther Dr. for .3 miles, past Thousand Oaks Dr. Take the next left into the Christ Lutheran Church parking lot. Park towards the back of the parking lot to the left if you are able. Please leave the front parking spaces near the building and to the right for those with mobility issues. There will be signs and hosts directing you to the proper entrance.

Coming to Christ using IH-35 northbound

1. Take exit 260, FM 2243/Leander Rd. Stay in the middle lane. Continue north on the access road .4 miles to the the next light, FM 2243/Leander Rd. Turn left, going west. Continue thru the next light at the access road on the other side of IH-35.
2. Continue west on Leander Rd and in .1 miles, turn left at the first street to the left, Luther Dr. Continue south on Luther Dr. for .3 miles, past Thousand Oaks Dr. Take the next left into the Christ Lutheran Church parking lot. Park towards the back of the parking lot to the left if you are able. Please leave the front parking spaces near the building and to the right for those with mobility issues. There will be signs and hosts directing you to the proper entrance.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER

The Rev. Dr. Gerald Kieschnick
"Being a Christian in 2018"

The Rev. Dr. Gerald B. Kieschnick served for nine years as national president of the 2.2 million-member Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. Upon completion of his third 3-year term in 2010, he and his wife Terry returned to Texas, where he served Concordia



University in Austin as Presidential Ambassador for Mission Advancement and developed Concordia's Christian Leadership Institute.

In 2016 Dr. Kieschnick returned to Lutheran Foundation of Texas, recently renamed Legacy Deo, where he had served from 1986-91 helping Christians use God's gifts to create a legacy for family and faith. In 2017 he became Legacy Deo's CEO.

A native Texan, Dr. Kieschnick received degrees from Texas A&M University (B.S., 1964), Concordia Theological Seminary (B.D., 1970); Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, Ind. (M.Div., 1977); and Concordia University, Austin, Tex. (LL.D., 1996).

Jerry and his wife of 51 years, Terry, have two grown children, Andrew Kieschnick and Angela (husband Todd) Keith and two grandchildren, Kolby Keith and Kayla Keith—all of whom live in Texas.
