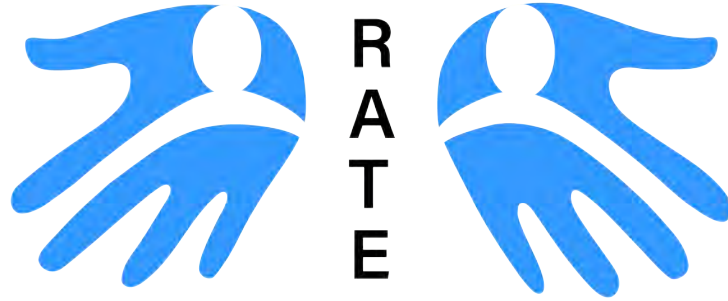

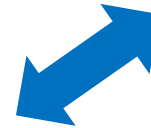

- Why did you choose to tell your Faith Story?TM

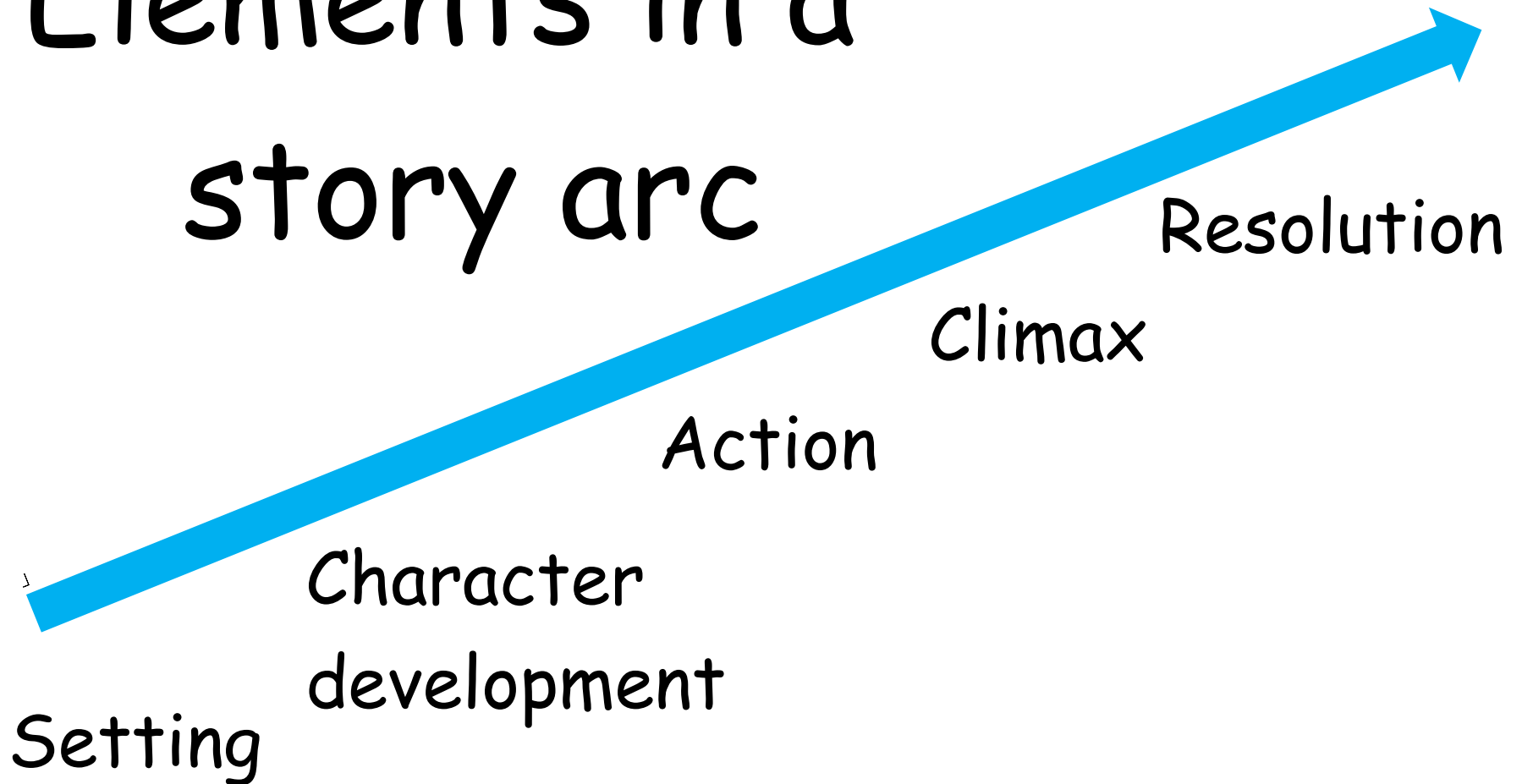
- Has the process been what you expected? What did you learn?

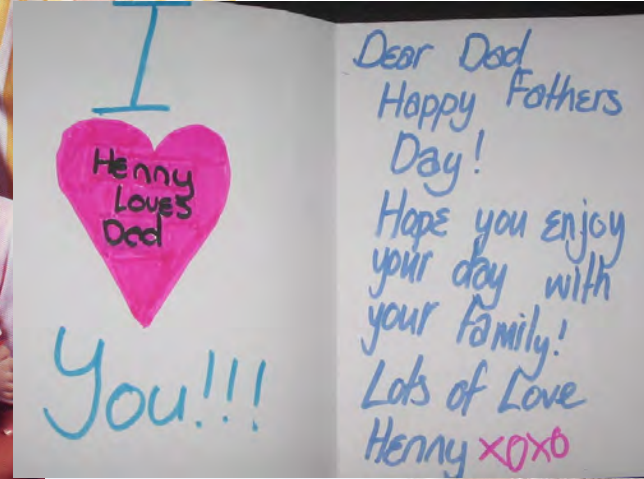
